GUIDE TO COMPETITORS

Griffith Off Road Club Inc invites your entry to our event in 2010.

Once again our Club has dared to be different and has bought back the endurance aspect into off road racing. You will start racing on Sunday at 7.30 am and race until the chequered flag drops.

All competitors will receive a DVD of the Event (1 per entry) and extra copies can be purchased for \$50 each.

From the Supplementary Regulations you will see that we have a big weekend of activities organized commencing with Scrutiny and Registration on Friday afternoon/evening being held at the Griffith Showground. Entry to the showground is via Murrumbidgee Avenue.

Once you have been through registration and scrutiny you must then position your vehicle in the display area where it will remain on display until released by officials. The general public have been invited to come along and inspect and interact with the competitors and teams. There will be food stalls, Sportzprint will be there with their merchandising and there will be entertainment for the children, big and small.

Camping is available over the weekend at the Griffith Showground. A powered site is \$50 and \$30 for an unpowered site.

An Accommodation Guide for Griffith listing motels and caravan parks is also attached.

Camping is allowed at the Track but Council has stipulated that there is to be no alcohol at all and all campers need to be registered. If you wish to camp at the Track a Camping Registration Form is attached and must be returned no later than 9 July 2010. Each person camping will need to be noted on the form/s. Griffith City Council has requested that this information be obtained and forwarded to them prior to the Event.

The following Council stipulations on entry to the Blue Dot Speedway area are to be adhered to over the weekend:

- Entry is permitted only as far as the Blue Dot Speedway lease area
- Persons are not permitted to wander onto the landfill or quarry site.
- Persons shall obey posted speed limits on site roads.
- Persons shall comply with the directions of Council staff and officials
- There shall be no excessive noise after 11 pm
- No alcohol is permitted in the Blue Dot Speedway lease area.

Mobil 98 (Synergy 8000) will be available, if we get enough orders. A Fuel Order Form is also attached setting out costs and conditions. Please note also that orders will need to be in and paid for by 9 July 2010. This fuel is being brought in especially for the Event.

Catering will be available at the track on Saturday and Sunday provided by Griffith Speedway Club.

Saturday's activities consist of briefing, reconnaissance of prologue and then prologue.

Performance Metals have put up a cash prize of \$1,000 for the Longest Jump. This activity will take place after the prologue. You must tick the box on the entry form to enter this activity. After completion of the longest jump activity, reconnaissance of the main track will commence.

You will note in the supplementary regulations that reconnaissance of the track can only be undertaken in road registered vehicles.

Sunday we will be up early for a briefing and racing will commence at 7.30 am.

See Supplementary Regulations for stipulations regarding refueling and only activities allowed in refueling area. All other repairs and activities to be undertaken will need to be done in the pits in your own time.

A Presentation Dinner commencing at 7.30 pm will be held at the Griffith Leagues Club, Jondaryan Avenue, Griffith. Tickets are \$35 each for adults, \$15 for children under 12, Children under 3 are free. The menu is attached. Tickets are limited to 250. Entry to the presentation is by ticket only.

Drinks on arrival (beer, wine, soft drink and orange juice) will be provided. As the number of tickets to the Presentation Dinner is limited it is advisable to order tickets with your entry.
