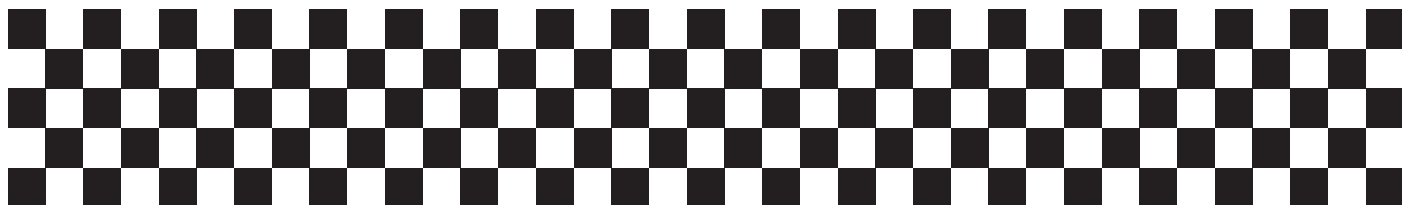
PLEASE HAVE YOUR PASSES READY TO PRESENT AT THE GATE ON ENTERING.

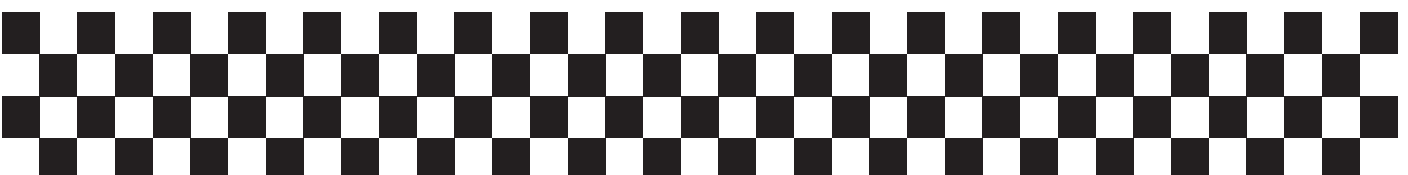

4. Crew briefing for event proper will be held at Event Headquarters.
5. Safety check. All vehicles must be checked for safety before starting event on Sunday morning, from 7.00 a.m. at the scrutiny tent in the pits.
6. Reminder – All CAMS licenses, log books, civil licenses and current club membership cards must be produced at the Secretary's Office when doing paperwork at scrutiny.
7. Rules for passing. It is the responsibility of the slower competitor to give way to an overtaking competitor, even if this means coming to a complete stop. The Stewards may impose a time penalty against any competitor, found in breach of this rule, or when two or more independent complaints against the competitor are made.
8. As cars will be lined up prior to prologue in their start order, any vehicle which is unable to present itself in order to the starter will be seeded at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Prologue start order will be emailed, when available, to competitors via email (if supplied), published on offroadracing.com.au, displayed at Friday night scrutiny and also a copy included in the Competitor packs which are received at scrutiny.
9. Results of the prologue will be posted in Sea Lake at the two hotels and two cafes and also distributed around the Rec Reserve and Green Lake campers as soon as possible after the day's activities.
10. Log books will be held by the Chief Scrutineer after scrutiny and are to be signed for and collected from Event Headquarters.
11. Exemption of a restriction relating to Local Law No. 10 – Consumption of Alcohol in a Public Place. This law is relevant to the Sea Lake Recreation Reserve camping area, an exemption has been approved and applies to allow consumption of alcohol in the Recreation Reserve until 1am Saturday, Sunday and Monday mornings. Note that alcohol consumed in other public places is not allowed. (e.g. walking from hotels to camping area.)
12. Sponsor stickers will be supplied to you at Scrutiny. We ask that you please respect our event sponsor and place the stickers on your vehicle. For those of you registered for the ARB Australian Off Road Racing Series, there will be stickers supplied to you that also need to be put on your car.
13. Pit/Paddock: Please note the times that the paddock area become the pits and vice versa. Refueling is not permitted in the paddock area so all refueling will need to be done before arriving at the track for each days competition, if you need to add fuel to your vehicle prior to commencing the days racing this will need to be done in the refuel area. On Saturday refueling is permitted between 10am and 2.15pm. For Sunday competition, refueling between laps 1 & 2, 3 & 4 MUST be done in the refuel area. Refueling in the service break, between laps 2 & 3, may be carried out in the pits.
14. **Please note** that the Presentation Evening is at the Sea Lake Community Complex, Complex Drive, Sea Lake A courtesy shuttle bus will run on the evening. The bus will leave from the 'Chook Shed' at 6.00pm stopping at the Top Pub and Bottom Pub on the way to the Complex. We plan to do a couple of trips but please don't leave it to the last bus to 'get on'. The bus will return to the street and the Rec. Reserve at the conclusion of the evening. The evening is **STRICTLY NO BYO**. Drinks will be at bar prices.
