REGULATIONS**

1. TITLE OF EVENT:

The event shall be known as the 'Millicent Sand Buggy Club Championship', a Multi Club Short Course Off Road Racing Event herein referred to as "The Event", shall be held under the provisions of the National Competition Rules (NCRs) of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance (AASA), the AASA Standing Regulations for Off Road Racing Events, the General Requirements for Automobiles for Off Road Racing Events, Off Road Automobiles Specific Regulations for Off Road Racing Events, these Supplementary Regulations and any further Regulations that may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with AASA Health, Safety & Environment policy, which can be found on the AASA website at www.aasa.com.au.

2. AASA PERMIT NUMBER : AASA190518/MSBC3145

3. PROMOTER/ORGANISER:

The promoter and organiser will be the Millicent Sand Buggy Club

4. THE COURSE:

The course will comprise of dirt tracks and will be approximately 150 km in length.

5. THE EVENT:

The event will be held on Saturday 19th May 2018 at Settlement Rd Mumbannar, 30kms East of Mount Gambier. The Event will be approximately 150 km in length, comprising 2 heats each of approximately 8 laps. The winner will be the crew with the lowest allocated time for the total of all sections contested.

8. JUDGES OF FACT:

All officials including Recovery, Observers & Check Point Officials will be deemed as Judges of Fact within their relevant fields of operation in regards to course shortening, shunting, deliberate balking or dangerous driving. Competitors are reminded that there is no right of protest against their decision.

9. PROTESTS:

Protests must be lodged direct to the Clerk of Course.in accordance with Section 18 of the NCRs.

10. LIMIT OF ENTRIES:

A minimum of 8 cars and a maximum of 30 cars will apply to the Event. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

12. COMPETITORS ELIGIBILITY:

Is open to all competitors holding the appropriate competition licence, but to be eligible for championship points you must be financial members of the Millicent Sand Buggy Club. All competitors 18 years of age or under must have written parental consent. Proof of age may be required.

13. REFUSAL:

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason, in accordance with the NCRs.

14. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Will only be accepted if the entry form is fully completed, accompanied by the appropriate fees and received at the Event Secretaries address on or before the due date.

15. Entries Open:

Early Entries Close Friday 11th May 2018 at 8:00pm

Entries Close Friday 18th May 2018 at 9:00pm

FEES PAYABLE: The Entry Fee \$200.00 (inc GST) if paid by 8-00pm Friday 11th May 2018 the entry fee will be \$150.00 (inc GST).

16. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY:

All vehicles must comply with the conditions outlined in the AASA General Requirements for Automobiles for Off Road Racing Events and AASA Off Road Automobiles Specific Regulations for Off Road Racing Events.

Classes One to Ten as specified within the regulations.

Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate suitable classes and may at their discretion subdivide classes.

17. STARTING ORDER & TIMING:

- A. Starting order will be determined by ballot. Vehicles will start one at a time at 15-second intervals. Actual race time allowed for each vehicle will be advised at crew briefing.
- B. Timing will be done with electronic clocks to the nearest whole second. The winner will be determined by the shortest allocated time. (Refer AASA Standing Regulations for Off Road Racing).

18. WITHDRAWALS:

Will be accepted on or before 8:00 am – 19th May 2018 in which case fees will be refunded in full after the next Club/Promoters meeting. Please contact Event Secretary on 0418 843 305

19. SAFETY

- A. All vehicles must be equipped (for each occupant) with side nets or wrist restraint (refer GR18, General Requirements for Automobiles for Off Road Racing)
- B. All vehicles must carry a Warning Triangle, First Aid Kit, and towrope. Warning Triangle & First Aid Kit to be readily accessible to persons outside the vehicle without removing panels. First Aid sticker should be positioned on the outside of the vehicle indicating the approximate location of the First Aid Kit.
- C. Each crew member is required to wear an approved helmet which complies with the minimum AS 1698 or higher. Approved goggles / visor to standard AS1609 to AS1681 shall be worn in all open vehicles and in closed vehicles with windscreens removed. Goggles fitted with glass lenses are not acceptable.
- D. Competitors are required to wear apparel as per the AASA NCR's.
- E. Each vehicle must be equipped with one or more hand held fire extinguishers complying with standard AS1841.5 or higher.
- F. An amber tail light, min 18 w and 60cm square area, and wired so that it operates at all times when the main power is switched on. No other switch is permitted.
- G. Roof numbers are compulsory.
- H. White background is required for the rear number.

20. AWARDS AND TROPHIES:

1st, 2nd, 3rd Outright Driver and Navigator, and 1st in class Driver and Navigator. To be a classified finisher you must complete at least 70% of the total competitive distance within the allotted late running time

21. SCRUTINY:

In order to have your vehicle scrutineered, please present your current Club Membership, Licence, Vehicle Passport, one Civil Drivers Licence / proof of age, Helmet, Vehicle and Racing Apparel to Event Headquarters at the time specified.

22. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Consumption of alcoholic beverages by drivers, navigators or pit crew is forbidden prior to the completion of the meeting in accordance with schedule 3 of the NCR's. All drivers must have a 0.00 BAC. Any driver or crew member being found to be under the influence of alcohol or recreational drugs during the course of the event will be excluded from the event.

23. REFUELLING:

Will only be done in the paddock or pits. Occupants must be out of the vehicle, motor switched off and have a fire extinguisher at hand before fuel tank caps and / or fuel container caps can be removed. Refuelling can only take place from containers of not more than 20 litre capacity.

24. **SIGNALLING TO COMPETITORS**

Green flag – Start of race

Red flag – Stop the race

Yellow flag – Danger

Black flag – Stop

Chequered flag – End of race

25. **INSURANCE**

Certain public, and personal accident insurance is provided under the AASA permit in relation to the event. Further details can be found at www.aasa.com.au.

26. **ABANDONMENT**

Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with the AASA NCR's

27. **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

A. **FACILITIES:** Toilets are on site *NO SHOWERS*

B. **CAMPING:** Area is available to camp for the Friday and Saturday night free of charge.

C. Catering will be available Saturday at the track BBQ, cold drinks.

D. **SPEED LIMIT** in paddock area is 10 km/hr.
