1. TITLE AND NATURE OF EVENT

The event is entitled the Waikerie Hotel ARB Riverland 300, herein after called the event, and will be a Long Course Off Road Event conducted at Enduro Road, 17kms west of Waikerie in the state of South Australia on Friday 13th July to Sunday 15^h July, 2018.

The event will be Round 4 of the 2018 ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship, Round 1 of the 2018 Element Off Road AORRA SA Off Road Racing Championship and Round 4 of the 2018 ARB SAORRA Multi Club Series.

2. AUTHORITY AND PERMIT

The event will be held under the National Competition Rules of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA), the Off Road Racing Regulations for AASA, the series regulations of the ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship, the SA Off Road Championship Sporting Regulations, the 2018 SAORRA Series Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations, instructions or bulletins which may be issued.

The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the AASA Health Safety and Environment policy which is available on their website at www.aasa.com.au

The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry, or if deemed appropriate the Clerk of Course may withdraw any entry on the grounds of safety, misconduct or inappropriate behaviour.

The organisers reserve the right to abandon, cancel or postpone the event as provided for in Section 1.4 of the AASA Standing Regulations (or to cancel the event if less than 25 entries are received by close of entries).

8. SCRUTINY

8.1 Times and Venues

Refer Article 12(l)-12(v) of the ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship Sporting Regulations.

Friday 13th July at Waikerie Community Sports Centre, enter via Smith Drive 3pm to 7pm

Vehicles must be presented as competition ready i.e. spare wheels, competition numbers. fitted etc.

Apparel as per AASA Off Road Technical Regulations

Vehicles will remain on display until 7pm or until released by the Clerk of the Course

Pit lighting will be in place at the track and we encourage competitors to set up after scrutiny.

8.2 Documentation

The following documentation will be checked prior to scrutiny AASA Off Road Competition Licences or approved equivalent, civil driving licences (where required), vehicle passports. Club Membership, proof of age if under 18 years. All competitors and service crew must sign the relevant disclaimer at documentation.

Vehicle passports/logbooks will be retained at Event Headquarters until the completion of competition and Return of timing transponder.

9. CREW BRIEFING/ SIGN ON

A briefing for competing crews will be conducted on Saturday 14th July at 10.45 am prior to the prologue, a further briefing will be held on Sunday 15th July at 8.15am **if deemed necessary** before the event proper. Briefings will take place at Event Headquarters. **Crew sign on is still compulsory sunday morning at 7.45 am at event headquarters.**

Attendance at crew briefing by each entered crew member is compulsory, and each competing crew member is required to sign on. Cases of non-attendance are to be referred to the stewards by way of a formal charge, which may result in a penalty.

10. RUNNING DETAILS

10.1 Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance of the entire course only will commence at 7.30 am on Saturday 14th July, 2018.

You will only be able to do reconnaissance in a road registered 4WD vehicle. Maximum speed for reconnaissance is **80kph**. Competitors who do not have access to a suitable road registered vehicle may make an application to the organisers no later than 7 days prior to the event to have suitable transport arranged. If you are not lined up in your vehicle ready to go at 7.30 am on Saturday you will not be permitted to start. **NO VEHICLES PERMITTED TO START ONCE SWEEP VEHICLE HAS LEFT.**

Each occupant in a vehicle being utilised on reconnaissance shall be part of a Crew or Service Crew named on the entry form for the event or sign a Passenger disclaimer and wear a seat belt at all times.

There will be **NO** reconnaissance of the prologue track.

10.2 Prologue

Sponsored by Sprint Freight & Logistics:

Prologue will be held on Saturday 14th July starting at 11.30pm. The length of the prologue course will be approx. 11 km. Prologue start order will be published on offroadracing.com.au and available at event documentation. Any competitors entering after 11th July will not be seeded and will start prologue rear of field.

All competitors will have the opportunity to run a second prologue. If the competitor chooses to do so they will forfeit their first prologue time. If you choose to do a second prologue you must nominate at event headquarters within a half hour of your first prologue start time. Second prologue start order will be same as previous.

Competitors not finishing the prologue may apply to the organisers to be seeded. The closing time for applications for seeding will be 30 minutes after last car completes prologue.

10.3 Dash for Cash

Sponsored by Mickey Thompson Tyres

To start as soon as possible after the prologue, the 10 fastest available cars may compete in a shootout of 2 laps of a shortened prologue track with 2 vehicle starting at a time on opposite sides of the track.

The Dash for Cash is not compulsory but cash and prizes are awarded to competitors

10.4 Event

The track will consist of sand, limestone and open paddocks and will be approx. 75kms long.
The event will consist of 4 laps for the ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship /Element Off Road SA Off Road Racing Championship competitors and 3 laps for the SAORRA Multi Club competitors.

There will be a one hour compulsory break to be taken at the completion of any lap but before commencement of final lap (lap four for state section and lap three for multi club only section) and cannot be taken part way through a lap.

The competition will start at 9.00 am on Sunday 15th July. (Refer Event Schedule for further details) and will be preceded by a prologue on Saturday 14th July to determine starting positions.
Other than for event scheduled times the track is private property and no one is permitted to be on it.

10.4a Race line up

The competitors finishing first and second in prologue will start on their own at 30 second intervals.
The rest of the field will start 2 at a time at 30 second intervals.

10.5 Refuelling

Refuelling can only be done in the designated pits. Occupants must be out of vehicle, motor switched off and crew member holding a fire extinguisher before fuel tank caps and/or fuel container caps can be removed.

All containers must be effectively sealed until needed for immediate use and all containers must be effectively resealed or removed before the crew may re-enter vehicle.

Refuelling must be carried out with a minimum 0.9kg fire extinguisher present. Refuelling on track will be at Clerk of the Courses discretion.

Fuel must be 'Commercial Fuel' or 'Diesel Fuel'.

10.6 Fuel containers in pits

Competitors should be aware that there is a South Australian Government Regulation.

* Maximum allowable 250 litres in transport. * Maximum standing (dispensing) 120 litres.

* NO 205 LITRE (44 GALLON) DRUMS WITH DISPENSER IN THE PITS

10.7 Allowed Time

SAORRA competitors will have 270 minutes (including 1 hour break) to complete their 3 laps.

ARB/State Championship competitors will have 340 minutes (including 1 hour break) to complete their 4 laps.

11. TIMING

Timing will be expressed in hours, minutes, seconds and hundredths of seconds. Each competitor will be given a time out card when taking their one hour break showing their start time for the next section. It is the competitors responsibility to report to the start area before their start time. Your time will start regardless of you being there or not.

Electronic timing will be used at this event. All competitors' vehicles will be fitted by the event with a supplied Transponder. The Transponder must be returned at the completion of competition for the vehicle when the Vehicles Passbook/Log book will be returned to the competitor. If the timing transponder is not returned at the event it is the responsibility of the competitor to express post return it to Race Time immediately.

If the transponder is lost, destroyed or not returned within 3 days a charge of \$450 will be applied.

Transponders remain the property of Race Time, but, all responsibility is held with the competitor during the event.

12. PENALTIES

Penalties for the event will be in accordance with the 2018 ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship Sporting Regulations and the 2018 ARB SAORRA Series Regulations.

13. PROTESTS

Protests may be made via the CRO who will refer to the Clerk Of Course. Upon judgement if the competitor is not satisfied a further protest may be lodged with the AASA Stewards along with the appropriate fee.

14. PIT AREA, PADDOCK AREA

- Pit and competing crews must wear their wristbands at all times whilst in the pit area
- Smoking and the consumption of alcohol are not permitted in the pit or welding area
- No unauthorised persons are permitted in the pit area.
- Crew members are reminded of their responsibility regarding the wearing of wristbands at all times and of the entry of unauthorised persons into their pit area.
- Welding/Grinding may only occur in the area designated for this purpose.
- The pit and paddock areas will be clearly signed and fenced.
- Entry in and out of the pit area must be via the designated entry point/s
- The pit speed limit is walking pace only (5km/hr)

Only tow and competition vehicles are permitted in pits

Breaches of these regulations may be referred to the Stewards by way of a formal charge, this may result in a penalty.

15. GENERAL

15.1 Recovery

Recovery will be affected during the running of the event by the official Recovery vehicles only.

No person/s other than authorised officials and crew member will be permitted on the course without permission of the Clerk of the Course or one of the Assistant Clerks of the Course.

Recovery vehicles will be identified by a white flag attached to the vehicle.

15.2 Sweep Vehicle

A sweep vehicle will traverse the entire course at the end of the event immediately after the last competing vehicle has commenced last lap.

15.3 Incident Reports

Competitors involved in any form of incident during the event must report to the Clerk of the Course as soon as possible but in any event not later than the finish of the event.

Vehicles which are involved in an accident involving damage must be re-examined by the Chief Scrutineer or his delegate before being permitted to take further part in the competition.

15.4 Safety

All competitors must comply with the current AASA regulations. All drivers and navigators must wear helmets and apparel as per the 2018 AASA Off Road Racing Apparel requirements.

15.5 Vehicle Eligibility

Refer to AASA vehicle eligibility criteria and classes.

15.6 Alcohol, Drugs & Other Substances

Any holder of a AASA 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with Schedule 3 of the AASA NCR's. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a AASA 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol.

15.7 Returning to Pits

Returning to pits to effect repairs to vehicles other than via Pit Entry gates from the Track will only be allowed when: being towed by a recovery vehicle, being Escorted by recovery vehicle or Via designated path off of the race track. YOU MAY REJOIN RACE FROM PIT EXIT and will have to re-run the lap you came in on OR second section of the track depending on which pit entry you came in on. Time for this lap will include unfinished lap time and repair time.

16. PASSES

Wristbands will be issued to all nominated crew members and officials. Wristbands will allow admittance to the event venue and access to the pit area.

17. POINTS & AWARDS

Outright trophies sponsored by Albins Performance Transmissions.

Trophies will be awarded for 1st 2nd & 3rd outright driver and navigator and 1st 2nd & 3rd in class for driver and navigator depending on the number of entries in each class. 6 or more entries 1st 2nd & 3rd. 5 entries 1st & 2nd. 3 or less 1st only. Any other trophies will be announced at drivers briefing.

SAORRA Multi Club Trophies will only be awarded to members of clubs affiliated with SAORRA.

ARB AUSTRALIAN OFF ROAD RACING CHAMPIONSHIP:

Points and series regulations will be as per ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship Regulations. Competitors must have registered prior the close of entry for this event to be eligible for series points.

SAORC POINTS:

SA Off Road Championship points will be awarded as per the 2018 Element Off Road AORRA South Australian Off Road Racing Championship series regulations. Competitors must have registered prior to close of entries for this event to be eligible for points.

SAORRA POINTS:

Will be awarded as per the 2018 ARB SAORRA Series Regulations

18. PROMOTIONAL / MEDIA ACTIVITY**18.1 A promotional/media passenger in vehicle activity will be conducted at the time detailed in the event schedule in accordance with the following criteria:**

Briefings for relevant crew are to be held prior to the activity.

The promotional activity will consist of 2 laps of a shortened prologue track.

19. INSURANCE

AASA Public Liability and Personnel Accident Insurance will be provided for Competitors, Competing Crew, nominated Service Crew & Officials.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Apex Club will provide meals at the track on Saturday & Sunday. Roast meal available Saturday night. Tickets will be available online at offroadracing.com.au when completing entry.

No fuel available at track.

Speed limit is 10km in camp grounds

Camping is permitted at track in designated areas only. There is **NO** camping in the pits.

Hot showers available. Camp fee for weekend is \$20 per person. Under 16 free

There will be Security in the pits from Saturday morning.

There will be an alcohol and noise curfew at 11pm Saturday night.

All dogs must be on a leash

No burning of crankcases is permitted

No quads or motorbikes or fireworks allowed.

Cans preferred by landowner. There will be no rubbish bins so please take all cans, rubbish etc. home.

Thank you.

The pits will be alcohol free at all times. Scrutiny tent only on Friday night.

If you damage fencing please report to Clerk of the Course or Event Secretary. If reported in the correct manner the Club will repair damage at no cost to the competitor if deemed no fault of driver. Club will not pay for wilful damage to property.

Please Note – any person found abusing the Waikerie venue e.g. wheelies, etc. will be charged and Forwarded to the Clerk of the Course of the meeting with a recommendation of exclusion. All competitors are Responsible for their crew and vehicles (being Competition or not). We have this venue under the condition that the Waikerie Riverland Off Road Assoc. leaves the grounds as they found them. No misconduct or anti-social behaviour will be tolerated what so ever.

All competitors & crew are reminded that they must conduct themselves in a manner that does not bring the sport into disrepute whilst in our community.
