SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The Can-Am Loveday 350 will be conducted at the Loveday 4x4Adventure Park, which is located 15km south of Barmera in the state of South Australia on Friday 25th October, Saturday 26th October and Sunday 27th October 2019.

The event is an Off Road Enduro and an Off Road Trophy Kart event.

The Off Road Enduro event is round 2 of the 2019 Element Off Road AORRA South Australian Off Road Racing Championship and round 2 of the SBH Engineering Loveday 600. The event is held under the National Competition Rules of Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd, (AASA) the AASA General Requirements Off Road Racing, AASA Technical Regulations Off Road Racing, these event regulations and any further regulations and bulletins issued. Please ensure you make yourselves familiar with all of these regulations at www.aasa.com.au, or Australian Off Road Racing Association.

ENTRY DETAILS

Entries for the Can-Am Loveday 350 open at 7pm 18th September 2019 and close at midnight Friday 18th October 2019.

The discounted entry fee for the Can-Am Loveday 350 is \$220.

Entries received after midnight Friday 4th October incur a premium entry fee of \$320.

SBH Engineering Loveday 600 – Combined entry fee is \$300

Can-Am Loveday 350 Off Road – Discounted entry fee is \$220

Can-Am Loveday 350 Off Road – Entry fee is \$320

Trophy Kart entry fee is \$120

There will be a \$20 per person admission fee into Loveday 4x4 Adventure Park, payable at the gate. This grants access for the weekend and applies to every person over 14 years of age. Under 14 free

Additional navigators may compete in an Off Road vehicle, providing they are properly nominated on the entry form. No additional fee is required.

Only the driver listed on the official entry form shall be permitted in each Trophy Kart during each practice, qualifying or race.

Names for pit crew MUST be entered with your entry form.

Entries for Off Road are limited to 80 and acceptance will be determined in order of receipt.

Entries can only be submitted via the official ONLINE Entry Form and must be accompanied by the requisite entry fee. A link to the on line entry form can be found on the event page at offroadracing.com.au

Entries withdrawn by advice TO THE EVENT SECRETARY before 8:00am on Friday, 25th October will receive a full refund.

Please quote your RACE VEHICLE NUMBER and DRIVERS SURNAME as reference number when paying by Direct Debit, so that payments can be accounted for.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse, or if deemed appropriate the Clerk of Course may withdraw any entry on the ground of safety, misconduct or inappropriate behaviour.

The organisers reserve the right to abandon, cancel or postpone the event if less than 25 off road entries are received by close of entries or adverse weather.

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

Trophy Kart

- (a) Each Off Road Kart shall be subject to a current AASA Passport (or approved equivalent)
- (b) Each vehicle shall also comply with the AASA General and Specific Requirements for Off Road Racing Vehicles.
- (c) Numbers must be at least the size required by the AASA General Requirement for Off Road Vehicles but for this event be larger, and be able to be clearly read by Track Officials.

Off Road

- (a) Vehicles must comply with AASA General Requirement for Off Road Vehicles for Classes Unlimited, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 66, 7, 8, 10.

CREW ELIGIBILITY

Trophy Kart

- (a) The event is open to financial members of TROPHYKART AUSTRALIA INC, or an AORRA affiliated club.
- (b) Each driver must hold a minimum of a AASA Club Off Road Racing License (or approved equivalent)
- (b) Unauthorised person/s in a race vehicle is prohibited.
- (c) Crew changes will be permitted, but only with Event Secretary's/Clerk of the Course's permission and all paperwork addressed before entering vehicle.
- (d) All Competitors MUST comply with the current AASA Regulations.

Off Road

- (a) Competitors competing for the Element Off Road AORRA South Australian Off Road Racing Championship points must comply with AASA State and or National Off Road Regulations, in particular, licence, apparel and safety requirements.
- (b) Other competitors must comply as a minimum with the AASA Club level requirements, in relation to licences apparel and safety equipment. These competitors are advised that although a Frontal Head Restraint is not required, it is highly recommended.

SAFETY

Trophy Karts

- (a) Each Vehicle must be fitted with window nets or wrist restraints.
- (b) All Competitors MUST comply with the current AASA Regulations. All drivers must wear helmets and apparel as per the 2018 AASA Off Road Racing Apparel requirements, complying with the Club Level standard.
- (c) A Safety harness complying with the General Requirements for Off Road Vehicles shall be fitted to each vehicle and worn at all times while competing.
- (d) A Frontal Head Restraint for all drivers, while not required, is highly recommended.
- (e) Each vehicle is required to be equipped with at least one (1) amber tail lamp that illuminates when ignition is on, and at least one (1) red Brake light.

Off Road

- (a) Vehicles must comply with AASA General Requirement for Off Road Vehicles.

EVENT NOTES

1. Refuelling

All Refuelling at the event venue must be done in the pit area in accordance with the Refuel Rules.

2. Restarting

Off Road competitors not completing a section may make application to the Clerk of Course to start the subsequent section. Cut-off times for receipt of such applications, is 15 minutes after the last vehicle completes the section.

3. Allowed Time

Off Road competitors are required to complete all sections to be classified a finisher. The allowed time for each section will be advised at the Competitor Briefings.

4. Penalties

- (a) Short cutting – 1st breach = 30 minutes, 2nd breach = exclusion
- (b) Causing damage to property deemed by the Clerk of the Course to have been deliberate = Exclusion
- (c) Refuelling whilst the engine is not switched off and/or any person is inside the vehicle and/or any person within 3 metres of the vehicle whilst being refuelled not dressed in non-flammable clothing from wrist to neck and ankle = Exclusion
- (d) Failure to obey flags, first breach = 30 minutes, second breach = Exclusion.

5. Pit Area & Passes

- (a) Pit and competing crews must display their passes on the outside of garments at all times whilst in the pit area
- (b) Smoking and the consumption of alcohol are not permitted in the pit, designated refuel area or welding area
- (c) No unauthorised persons, including persons under the age of 16, are permitted in the pit area unless competing.
- (d) Crew members are reminded of their responsibility regarding the entry of unauthorised persons into their pit area.
- (e) Welding may only occur in the area designated for this purpose.
- (f) The pit and paddock areas will be clearly signed and fenced.
- (g) Entry in and out of the pit area must be via the designated entry point/s.
- (h) The maximum permitted speed is 20kph.
- (i) Only one non competition vehicle per entry will be permitted into the pit area. (This includes the tow vehicle.)
- (j) Passes/wrist bands will be issued to all nominated crew members and officials
- (k) Breaches of these regulations may be referred to the Clerk of Course which may result in a penalty.

6. Recovery

Official recovery vehicles, identified by a white flag, will attend to all disabled vehicles throughout the event. Disabled competition vehicles will be towed to the pits. Competition vehicles that are unable to be towed will be moved to a safe position and may not be recoverable until the completion of the event. The crews of such vehicles will be taken to the pits.

NO UNAUTHORISED RECOVERY WILL BE TOLERATED.

7. Incident reports and reporting

Incident report forms will be available at Event Headquarters and must be completed as soon as possible.

Vehicles which are involved in an accident involving damage shall be re-examined by the Chief Scrutineer or his delegate before being permitted to take further part in the competition.

8. Timing and Start Lights/Flags – Off Road only

- (a) Timing begins when the signal to start is given.
- (b) Times to one thousandths of a second will be recorded on every lap and lap/s within the time allowed will be counted.
- (c) Electronic timing will be used at this event.
 - All competition vehicles will be fitted with a supplied transponder.
 - The transponder must be returned at the completion of competition. Only then will the log book will be returned to the competitor.
 - If the transponder is not returned at the event it is the responsibility of the competitor to express post return it to RaceTime immediately.
 - If the transponder is lost, destroyed or not returned within three days, a charge of \$450 will be applied.
 - Transponders remain the property of Race Time, but, all responsibility is held with the competitor during the event.

9. SAORC Points

SA Off Road Championship points will be awarded as per the 2019 Element Off Road AORRA South Australian Off Road Racing Championship series regulations.

Competitors must have registered on line prior to the close of entries for this event to be eligible for points.

10. Miscellaneous

- The maximum permitted speed in non-competition areas is 20km/h.
- No persons other than officials, accredited media or competing crew shall be permitted on the course.
- No Glass Bottles or Glass Containers

- No fuel will be available at the track
- Catering will be available from Friday evening for the whole weekend.
- Speed limit in the camping area is 10km
- A noise curfew applies from 11pm on Friday and Saturday night
- Camping is available at the track and is included in the venue entry fee.
- No animals in or around the tavern or lawn area.
- No burning of crank cases, tyres or rubbish.
- Please place all rubbish in the bins provided.
- No BYO drinks into the tavern or grassed area's
- No quads or bikes allowed. (organisers excepted)
- No collecting of firewood on the property.
- No night driving except on main access road to enter or leave the venue.
