

Supplementary Regulations

Motorsport Australia Permit Number: 520/2606/01

The Ronco Motors Loveday 280 will be conducted at the Loveday 4x4Adventure Park, located 15km south of Barmera, South Australia on Saturday 27th June and Sunday 28th June 2020.

AUTHORITY AND PERMIT

The Ronco Motors Loveday 280 is a multi-club event held under the:

- FIA International Sporting Code, including Appendices
- Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules
- Motorsport Australia General Requirements
- Motorsport Australia General Regulations
- Motorsport Australia Tribunal and Judicial Procedures
- Motorsport Australia Off Road Standing Regulations
- Motorsport Australia Off Road General Requirements
- Motorsport Australia Off Road Specific Requirements
- These Supplementary Regulations, Further Regulations and/or Bulletins which may be issued.
- Motorsport Australia Covid-19 Return to Race Strategy, Policies, Procedures and Guidelines

The Ronco Motors Loveday 280 will be conducted under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Safety 1st Risk Management and Occupational Health and Safety policies, which can be found at www.motorsport.org.au

COVID-19 HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event. This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, fatigue, or lack of sense of smell.

Under no circumstances should anyone attend the event if they have been

- overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- in contact with someone who has been overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- in contact with a known COVID-19 positive case in the previous 14 days.

Competitors are reminded that the Motorsport Australia Return to Race Strategy mandates that Spectators are not permitted at the event.

COVID-19 RETURN TO RACE REQUIREMENTS

Competitors are advised to read the Covid-19 Motorsport Australia Return to Race document prior to the event. **Following are areas that vary significantly to the pre Covid-19 era.**

1. ENTRY FORM

The Ronco Motors Loveday 280 will be using the offroadracing.com.au online event entry system. There is additional information that is required to reduce contact at the event.

You will need to have .jpg (photo) or pdf file of the following to be uploaded with your entry

- Motorsport Australia Competition licence (front)
- Motorsport Australia affiliated club card (front)
- Motorsport Australia Log Book (page that has logbook number, owner and address and the page that shows at least the last participation entry)

2. SERVICE / PIT CREW NOMINATION

Service/pit crew are now nominated on a separate online form, which can only be accessed after an event entry has been submitted.

Three (3) service/pit crew will be allowed per competition vehicle.

You have until the close of entries, 7pm Tuesday 23rd June, to submit your service/pit crew. Once that form has been submitted, there will be no additions to your service/pit crew. **No service crew will be added at the event.** If you do not require any service/pit crew, you still need to submit the form with 'none' selected for the amount of crew.

You will be required to supply the following details for your service/pit crew.

- First name and Last name for all service crew
- Phone Number for all service crew
- Address for all service crew
- Age bracket of service crew member (16-17, 18 plus)

The details submitted will assist the organisers in meeting their Covid-19 obligations for contact tracing.

The Ronco Motors Loveday 280 are using a paddock/pit format. To have access to the pit area during competition, service crew must be nominated here. To work on a competition vehicle in the paddock, service crew must be nominated.

3. EVENT DOCUMENTATION / COMPETING AND SERVICE CREW CHECK IN

All competing crew and service crew will need to sign the event entry disclaimer and be given their wristband event identification. Refer to the event schedule for the allocated times (Competing and Service Crew Check In). Please abide by social distancing regulations. The need for licences and club memberships to be sighted has been negated by the electronic lodgement and pre event checks. Logbooks are still required to be kept by the Chief Scrutineer until the end of competition.

4. DUAL OCCUPANT VEHICLE DECLARATION

Where a competition vehicle has two seat and two competing crew, both crew members must complete the Dual Occupant Vehicle Declaration Saturday 27th and Sunday 28th June before competition starts. Time has been allocated in the schedule as Competitor Crew Check In. Temperature checks may also be done at this time.

5. SELF SCRUTINY

There will be no in-person scrutiny at the Ronco Motors Loveday 280. Competitors will be required to Self Scrutinise their competition vehicles, apparel and safety devices and complete the Self-Scrutiny Checklist and Declaration Form. These forms will be attached to the confirmation of the event entry email and must be completed and submitted by the online upload form before 7pm Tuesday 23rd June 2020. Failure to return the forms may result in your entry declared null and void.

6. SCRUTINY SPOT CHECKS

Scrutiny spot check will be carried out at anytime throughout the event to check compliance.

Should it be found that a Competitor, Driver or Co-Driver/Navigator is using non-compliant apparel or has otherwise competed in a non-compliant vehicle, be it a safety or eligibility non-compliance, then that Competitor, Driver or Co-driver/Navigator must be referred to the Clerk of the Course/Stewards, in accordance with the NCR and the Motorsport Australia Return to Race Strategy.

The Clerk of the Course/Stewards will be required to investigate the matter, as appropriate, and ensure that action is taken commensurable with the infringement which may include disqualification from the event and any other penalty as deemed necessary.

7. APPAREL

There is to be no sharing of apparel. All participants must provide and wear their own event-specific protective apparel.

8. VENUE ENTRY

When entering the main gate to the venue, all persons will be required to provide their name and phone number for contact tracing purposes. Please be patient. **The main gate will be closed from 11:00pm to 6am Friday and Saturday nights.**

9. SOCIAL DISTANCING

Please be aware of and abide by all the Government requirements for social distancing. It is strongly recommended that all participants download that Covid-19 Stay Safe App.

10. COMPETITOR BRIEFING

There will not be a group gathering competitor briefing. Competitors will be emailed a briefing document prior to the event and will sign to confirm that they have read such document when signing the entry form and collecting their wristband event identification.

Entry fee includes Motorsport Australia fees, medical services fees, transponder hire, track reinstatement and officials support.

Premium Entry Fee may not be eligible for awards and trophies.

Entries are limited to 60 and acceptance will be determined in order of receipt.

Entries withdrawn by advice to the Event Secretary before 12noon Friday 26th June 2020 will receive a refund of monies paid less a \$25 administration fee.

Entries can only be submitted via the official ONLINE Entry Form and must be accompanied by the requisite entry fee. A link to the on line entry form can be found on the event page at offroadracing.com.au.

Please quote your RACE VEHICLE NUMBER and DRIVERS SURNAME as reference number when paying by Direct Debit, so that payments can be accounted for.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse, or if deemed appropriate the Clerk of the Course may withdraw any entry on the grounds of safety, misconduct or inappropriate behaviour.

RUNNING DETAILS

The Ronco Motors Loveday 280 will consist of a prologue of 6km to determine the start order for Section 1. The event comprises 7 laps of the 40km course, segmented into five sections. The 2 lap sections will consist of a minimum of one heat. This will be determined by the number of entries and at the Clerk of the Course's discretion, and advised to competitors. The surface of the course will be a combination of gravel, dirt and natural surfaces. Refer to the event schedule for running times.

THE VENUE

There will be a \$20 per person admission fee into Loveday 4x4 Adventure Park, payable at the gate. This grants access for the weekend and applies to every person over 14 years of age. Under 14 free

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY AND SAFETY

All vehicles must comply with the conditions outlined in the 2020 Motorsport Australia Manual.

COMPETING CREW ELIGIBILITY

1. The following Motorsport Australia licences are valid for this event
CO, NO, CON, NON, COJ, NOJ, CONJ, NONJ, ORSE, ORNSE. ORSE and ORNSE licences must be ordered and the \$107 fee paid with the online event entry. A pdf of the licence will be emailed to the competitor to be completed and uploaded to the online entry system before the close of premium entries.
2. The minimum age for a Driver/Co-Driver is 14 and the minimum age for a navigator is 12. Competing Crew aged 12 to 17 years must have written parental consent. Proof of age may be required.
3. Competing Crew must be a financial member of one of the listed Motorsport Australia affiliated clubs - Adelaide Buggy Club, Limestone Coast Off Road Club, Onkaparinga Ramblers Car Club, Summit Racing Team Car Club, Trophy Karts Australia.

REFUELLING

All Refuelling at the event venue must be done in the designated pit area in accordance with the refuel rules and not in the paddock area or camping grounds.

RESTARTING / SEEDING

Competitors not completing prologue or a section may make application to the Clerk of Course to be seeded into the start order for the subsequent section. Cut-off times for seeding applications is 15 minutes after the last vehicle completes the prologue or section.

JUDGES OF FACT

The Clerk of the Course, timekeepers, starter, control officials and recovery crew will be deemed Judges of Fact with regard to whether or not a vehicle follows the prescribed course as well as relative order, time of arrival and direction of entry into control points, start procedure and jumping the start. Competitors are reminded that there is no right of protest against the decision of a Judge of Fact.

PENALTIES

- a) Short cutting/deviation/wrong direction – 1st breach = 30 minutes, 2nd breach = EXCLUSION
- b) Causing damage deemed by the Clerk of the Course to have been deliberate = EXCLUSION
- c) Refuelling not in the refuel area and/or whilst the engine is not switched off and/or any person is inside the vehicle and/or any person within 2 metres of the vehicle whilst being refuelled not dressed in non-flammable clothing from wrist to neck and ankle = EXCLUSION
- d) Failure to obey flags, first breach = 30 minutes, second breach = EXCLUSION.

PIT AREA, PADDOCK AND WRISTBANDS

- a) The Ronco Motors Loveday 280 will be using a pit and paddock format. Repairs and servicing during a section must be done in the designated pit area. Anyone returning to the paddock area during a competitive section will be deemed a DNF for that section.

- b) Competitors will be able to restart the lap they were on if they are escorted or towed by recovery to the pits, or they enter the pit at the end of the first lap of the two lap sections, providing that they have adequate allowed race time to complete that lap.
- c) Competing crew and Service Crew must display their wristbands on the outside of garments at all times whilst in the pit area
- d) Smoking and the consumption of alcohol are not permitted in the pit, designated refuel area or welding area
- e) No unauthorised persons, including persons under the age of 16, are permitted in the pit area unless competing.
- f) Crew members are reminded of their responsibility regarding the entry of unauthorised persons into their pit area.
- g) Welding may only occur in the area designated for this purpose.
- h) The pit and paddock areas will be clearly signed.
- i) Entry in and out of the pit area must be via the designated entry point/s.
- j) The maximum permitted speed is 20kph.
- k) Breaches of these regulations may be referred to the Clerk of Course which may result in a penalty.

RECOVERY

Official recovery vehicles, identified by a white flag, will attend to all disabled vehicles throughout the event. Disabled competition vehicles will be towed to the pits. Competition vehicles that are unable to be towed will be moved to a safe position and may not be recoverable until the completion of the event. The crews of such vehicles will be taken to the pits.

NO UNAUTHORISED RECOVERY WILL BE TOLERATED.

INCIDENT REPORTS AND REPORTING

Incident report forms will be available at Event Headquarters and must be completed as soon as possible.

Vehicles which are involved in an accident involving damage shall be re-examined by the Chief Scrutineer or his delegate before being permitted to take further part in the competition.

PROTESTS

Any protest must be lodged according to the provisions of part XII of the National Competition Rules.

RECONNAISSANCE

Competition crew will be given the opportunity to reconnoitre the course proper once only in a suitable road registered vehicle – you must have proof of registration if requested. No vehicle will be permitted to start reconnaissance after the sweep vehicle departs.

TIMING AND TRANSPONDERS

Timing begins when the signal to start is given. Times will be recorded to one thousandths of a second on every lap within the time allowed.

- a) A competitor's result shall be the total elapsed time for all laps, passing through controls.
- b) A vehicle that arrives to the start line after its schedule starting time will be allowed to start at the next safe time or at the discretion of the Clerk of Course, provided it does not impede the start of any other competitor. The elapsed time begins on the original schedule starting time.
- c) Electronic timing will be used at this event. All competition vehicles will be fitted with a supplied transponder. The transponder must be returned at the completion of competition. Only then will the LogBook will be returned to the competitor.
- d) If the transponder is not returned at the event it is the responsibility of the competitor to express post return it to RaceTime immediately.
- e) If the transponder is lost, destroyed or not returned within three days, a charge of \$350 will be applied.
- f) Transponders remain the property of RaceTime, but all responsibility is held with the competitor during the event.

AWARDS

Outright trophies

1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded to Driver and Navigators.

Class trophies

1st in class where there is 3 or less entries in a class

1st, 2nd and 3rd where there is 4 or more entries in a class

MISCELLANEOUS

- a) The maximum permitted speed in non-competition areas is 20km/h.
- b) Only officials, accredited media or competing crew are permitted on the course.
- c) No glass bottles or glass containers
- d) No fuel will be available at the track
- e) Catering will be available from Friday evening for the weekend.
- f) A noise curfew applies from 11pm on Friday and Saturday night
- g) Camping is available at the track and is included in the venue entry fee.
- h) No animals in or around the tavern or lawn area.
- i) No burning of crank cases, tyres or rubbish.
- j) Please place all rubbish in the bins provided.
- k) No BYO drinks into the tavern or grassed area's
- l) No quads or bikes allowed (organisers excepted)
- m) No collecting of firewood on the property.
- n) No night driving except on main access road to enter or leave the venue.

CANCELLATIONS, ABANDONMENT OR ALTERATIONS

In accordance with the provisions of Item 16 of Off Road Standing Regulations, the promoters reserve the right to postpone, cancel or abandon the Ronco Motors Loveday 280 if less than 25 entries are received by 7pm Thursday 18th June 2020, and/or in their opinion, the conditions constitute force majeure as outlined in NCR 59. If the event is terminated when part run, the organizers shall determine results among those competitors who have not retired or been excluded to that point.

INSURANCE
