The Event shall be known as the Century Batteries Wynarka Enduro hereinafter referred to as “The Event” and shall be held under the:

- FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices
- Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules
- Motorsport Australia General Requirements
- Motorsport Australia General Regulations
- Motorsport Australia Tribunal and Judicial Procedures
- Motorsport Australia Off Road Standing Regulations
- Motorsport Australia Off Road General Requirements
- Motorsport Australia Off Road Specific Requirements
- These Supplementary Regulations, Further Regulations and/or Bulletins which may be issued
- Motorsport Australia Covid-19 Return to Race Strategy, Policies, Procedures and Guidelines.

The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Safety 1<sup>st</sup> Risk Management and Occupational Health and Safety policies, which can be found at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au)

**COVID-19 HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event. This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, fatigue or loss of sense of smell.

Under no circumstances should anyone attend the event if they have been

- (i) Overseas in the previous 14 days
- (ii) Visited regional Victoria and Melbourne Covid-19 in the previous 14 days
- (iii) Visited regional NSW and Sydney Covid-19 hotspots in the previous 14 days
- (iv) In contact with someone who has been overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- (v) In contact with a known Covid-19 positive case in the previous 14 days.

Entry fee includes Motorsport Australia fees, medical services fees, timekeeping, Summit RTCC weekend membership, track reinstatement and officials support.

Entries are limited to 40 and acceptance will be determined in order of receipt.

Entries withdrawn by advice to the Event Secretary before Friday 7<sup>th</sup> August 2020 will receive a refund of monies paid less a \$25.00 administrative fee.

Entries can only be submitted via the official ONLINE Entry Form and must be accompanied by the requisite entry fee. A link to the on line entry form can be found on the event page at [offroadracing.com.au](http://offroadracing.com.au).

Please quote your RACE VEHICLE NUMBER and DRIVER'S SURNAME as reference number when paying by direct debit to enable payments to be accounted for.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse, or if deemed appropriate the Clerk of the Course may withdraw any entry on the grounds of safety, misconduct or inappropriate behaviour.

The following documents must be provided;

- Current Motorsport Australia Licence Clubman Off Road or Motorsport Australia Clubman Off Road Navigator
- Current Motorsport Australia affiliated club **Membership Card**
- Motorsport Australia **Vehicle Logbook** (where issued)

## RUNNING DETAILS

The Event will consist of a prologue to determine the start order for Section 1.

Section 1 will comprise 6 laps of the 20 km course – allowed time 25 minutes per lap

Section 2 will comprise 8 continuous laps – allowed time 25 minutes per lap

Refer to the event schedule for running times.

## THE VENUE

Camping fees of \$10.00 per person (children under 12 free) will be collected at the gate. These monies will be donated to the Karoonda Lions Club. The track is found by turning right off the main road from Murray Bridge to Karoonda. At Wynarka take the Moorlands Road, continue along the dirt road for approximately 2 kms. The track entrance will be marked on the left hand side of the road.

## VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY AND SAFETY

All vehicles must comply with the conditions outlined in the 2020 Motorsport Australia Manual.

## COMPETING CREW ELIGIBILITY

Competing crews must be a financial member of the Summit Racing Team Car Club Inc. If you are not a member of the Summit Racing Car Club you will be able to take out a weekend membership with the Club to enable you to complete.

Crews should complete a **Dual Occupant Vehicle Declaration Form** – available on the [Motorsport Australia Website](#).

## **REFUELLING**

All refuelling at the event venue must be done in the designated pit area in accordance with the refuel rules and not in the camping grounds.

## **ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

## **JUDGES OF FACT**

The Clerk of Course, timekeepers, starter, control officials and recovery crew will be deemed Judges of Fact with regard to whether or not a vehicle follows the prescribed course as well as relative order, time of arrival and direction of entry into control points, start procedure and jumping the start. Competitors are reminded that there is no right of protest against the decision of a Judge of Fact.

## **PENALTIES**

1. Short cutting/deviation/wrong direction - up to and including exclusion
2. Causing damage deemed by the Clerk of Course to have been deliberate – up to and including exclusion
3. Refuelling not in the refuel area and/or whilst the engine is not switched off and/or any person is inside the vehicle and/or any person with 2 metres of the vehicle whilst refuelling not dressed in non-flammable clothing from wrist to neck and ankle – up to and including exclusion.
4. Failure to obey flags – up to and including exclusion.

## **PIT AREA AND WRISTBANDS**

1. The Event will be using a pit area. Repairs to vehicles other than via the Pit Entry gates from the track will only be allowed when:
  - Being towed by a recovery vehicle
  - Being escorted by a recovery vehicle

You may rejoin the race from the PIT EXIT ONLY and will have to re-run the lap you came in on.

2. Competing crew and Service Crew must display their wristbands on the outside of garments at all times whilst in the pit area.
3. Smoking and the consumption of alcohol are not permitted in the pits, designated refuel area or welding area.
4. No unauthorised persons, including persons under the age of 16 are permitted in the pit area unless competing.
5. Crew members are reminded of their responsibility regarding the entry of unauthorised persons in their pit area.
6. Welding may only occur in the area designated for this purpose.

7. The pit area will be clearly signed.
8. Entry in and out of the pit area must be via the designated entry points.
9. The maximum permitted speed is 20kph.
10. Breaches of these regulations may be referred to the Clerk of Course which may result in a penalty.

#### **RECOVERY**

Official recovery vehicles, identified by a white flag, will attempt to attend to all disabled vehicles throughout the event. Competition vehicles that are unable to be towed will be moved to a safe position and may not be recoverable until the completion of the event.

#### **INCIDENT REPORTS AND REPORTING**

Incident report forms will be available at Event Headquarters and must be completed as soon as possible.

Vehicles which are involved in an accident involving damage shall be re-examined by the Chief Scrutineer or his delegate before being permitted to take further part in the Event.

#### **PROTESTS**

Any protest must be lodged according to the provisions of part X11 of the National Competition Rules.

#### **ABANDONMENT**

The organisers reserve the right to abandon, cancel, postpone, terminate or alter the Event in accordance with NCR 59 and may cancel the Event if fewer than 20 entries are received.

#### **RECONNAISSANCE**

Competing crew will be given the opportunity to reconnoitre the court proper in a suitable road registered vehicle – you must have proof of registration if requested. No vehicle will be permitted to start reconnaissance after the sweep vehicle departs.

#### **TIMING**

Timing begins when the signal to start is given. Times will be recorded to 100<sup>th</sup> of a second.

1. A competitor's result shall be the total elapsed time for all laps.
2. A vehicle that arrives to the start line after its scheduled starting time will be allowed to start at the next safe time or at the discretion of the Clerk of Course, provided it does not impede the start of any other competitor. The elapsed time begins on the original schedule start time.
3. OLT's will be carried out during prologue.
4. Prologue starting intervals will be a minimum of 1 minute between vehicles and a minimum of 2 minutes between classes.

#### **AWARDS**

Outright trophies

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> will be awarded to Driver and Navigator

Class trophies

1<sup>st</sup> in class where there is 3 or less entries in a class

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> where there is 4 or more entries in a class.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

1. The maximum permitted speed in non-competition vehicles areas is 10 km/h
2. Only officials, accredited media or competing crew are permitted on the course.

3. No glass bottles or glass containers
4. No fuel will be available at the track
5. Catering will be available via the Karoonda Lions Club from Saturday morning for the weekend
6. A noise curfew applied from 11pm on Friday and Saturday.
7. Camping is available at the track with hot showers available. Camp fee of \$10.00 person applies to persons over the age of 12 years.
8. No burning of crank cases, tyres or rubbish.
9. Please place all rubbish in bins provided.
10. No unofficial bikes or trikes allowed.
11. Large transporter trucks please park behind the line of the catering shed so as not to impose the view.
12. No practice allowed.
