9. Scrutiny

Self-Scrutiny will be undertaken by each competitor, by inspecting their vehicle and completing the attached forms prior to the event and **emailing them back to the event secretary no later than Tuesday 2 March 2021 - rainbowrises240@gmail.com**. **If the forms are not returned, you cannot race.**

All vehicles need to comply with the Motorsport Australia Off-Road Standing Regulations and General Requirements of Off-Road vehicles.

The two forms to be completed are listed below and will be emailed to all competitors:

- **Self-Scrutiny Checklist - Off Road** and signed by the competitor (make sure your vehicle number is on the form)
- **Motorsport Australia-Self-Statement-of-vehicle-compliance**

9.1 Spot checks - Scrutineers will be conducting spot checks throughout Saturday - taking place at each vehicles pit area, and at a minimum they will be **checking apparel, seat belts and cutters, fire extinguishers, safety items, running lights, etc.** Only competing crew should be present during spot checks and apparel checking.

9.2 Apparel Scrutiny - conducted at the vehicles pit area. Apparel items are to be laid out on the vehicle bonnet or another suitable surface, e.g. table with compliance labels and identification information visible for inspection. A team member will be the only person allowed to handle their own apparel during any inspection.

9.3 Transponders - the Chief Scorer will attach a timing transponder to each vehicle in their pit area on Saturday between 8.30am and 11.00am.

9.4 Documentation – all licences, affiliated club membership and log books will be checked online prior to the event to ensure they are valid and current. There will be Competitor Check-In – where all competitors and crew must sign the relevant disclaimers.

9.4 Log Book - must be handed in at competitor check-in. Your log book can be collected upon the return of the transponder to Event Headquarters. If the log book is another name to the drive, then we need a letter of Authority from the Owner to authorise the drive to compete the car (use the [Automobile Legal Owner's Declaration](#) form).

9.5 Competitor Non-compliance: Should a competitor present non-compliant apparel, seat belts, fire extinguishers or present a non-compliant vehicle, that competitor will be referred to the Clerk of Course and Stewards in accordance with the NCR's and the Motorsport Australia Return to Race Strategy.

10. Crew Sign On and Briefing

There will not be a group gathering competitor briefing. Competitors will be emailed a briefing document prior to the event and will sign to confirm that they have read such document when signing the entry form and collecting their wristband event identification at Competitor Check-In.

Any further changes will be communicated via event bulletins.

10.1 Competitor Check-In - All competitors and pit crew must attend the Competitor Check-In desk at the end of pits, when instructed by our Pit Official, during the times specified as per the event schedule, to sign disclaimers and Multi Occupant Vehicle declaration - both Saturday and Sunday.

11. Running Details

11.1a General

The venue for the Event will be private property approximately 1 km west of Rainbow on Rainbow Rises Road. The Event will consist of the following.

VORC 28 laps of the approximately 8.7km course (243.6 km in total). 5 sections of 1, 8, 6, 6 & 7 laps.

VORCS 15 laps of the approximately 8.7km course (130.5 km in total). 3 sections of 1, 8, & 6 laps.

The Event will be conducted over four (5) sections for VORC and three (3) sections for VORCS.

Section 1 start order will be determined by the event organisers and cars will start one at a time, 30 seconds apart.

Section 2, 3, 4 & 5 - Vehicles will start one vehicle at a time, 20 seconds apart. The number of cars within the groups and the cars in each group will be determined by the Clerk of Course. Vehicles in the next group must be on the dummy grid 30 minutes after the commencement of the previous group.

Section 3, 4 & 5 groups will be re-order based on previous section results within your group.

The total number of cars will be divided in to three groups per section, the start order for each section will be based on previous section results. Groups can be reorganised at the Clerk of Courses discretion.

11.9 Section Time

Crews shall complete a section within the time allowed as follows:

Section 1 – 1 laps (VORC & VORCS) time allowed 10 minutes - Saturday

Section 2 – 8 laps – time allowed 1hr 15 minutes (VORC & VORCS) - Saturday

Section 3 – 6 laps – time allowed 55 minutes (VORC & VORCS) - Sunday

Section 4 – 6 laps – time allowed 55 minutes (VORC) - Sunday

Section 5 – 7 laps – time allowed 1hr 05 minutes (VORC) - Sunday

To be classified a finisher of the event for trophies, the Crew shall complete 75% of the laps, as appropriate for VORC & VORCS.

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14.9 Wrist bands

Everyone on the site at the event must have a wristband. All officials will be issued with a wristband at Check-In, all competitors and crews will be issued with a wristband at Competitor Check-In. Anyone other than those listed above must check in via our COVID Check In via QR code and be issued a wristband by an official. This will ensure we have everyone on sites contact details.
